THE THIRD SUNDAY OF ADVENT

"Rejoice: the Lord is nigh!" As Christmas draws near, the Church emphasises the joy which should be in our hearts over all that the birth of our Saviour means for us. The great joy of Christians is to see the day drawing near when the Lord will come again in His glory to lead them into His kingdom. The oft-repeated Veni ("Come") of Advent is an echo not only of the prophets but also of the conclusion of the Apocalypse of St. John: "Come, Lord Jesus." the last words of the New Testament.

This third Sunday of Advent is known as Gaudete Sunday. The term Gaudete refers to the first word of the Entrance Antiphon, "Rejoice". Rose vestments are worn to emphasise our joy that Christmas is near, and we also light the rose candle on our Advent wreath.

YEAR OF MERCY

We celebrated the Year of Mercy in Assembly with the children on Tuesday. We talked about what it means to show mercy or to be merciful. Some examples include: when you put the needs of others before your own needs OR when you forgive your friend. Children in KS2 discussed the image (google Merciful Like the Father) for the Year of Mercy — why don't you google it at home and ask your children to explain the meaning in this image. During the course of the Church's year we will have special Year of Mercy assemblies. Parents/Carers will be invited to attend.
