ASH WEDNESDAY AND LENT

Next week we will have an Ash Wednesday Service, led by Fr Liam, in school at 2pm. Everyone is welcome. To help prepare your child for Lent we would be really grateful if you could discuss with them how the ashes are made (last year's Palm leaves are burnt and mixed with holy water or oil) and that when the Priest puts the ashes on our head in the sign of the cross he says, "Repent and believe in the good news." The good news is the Gospel, so the Priest is calling us to be sorry for our sins and to follow in Jesus' footsteps. Ash Wednesday is the first day of Lent, the season of preparation for the resurrection of Jesus Christ on Easter Sunday. During assembly next week we will discuss why we make a sacrifice during Lent and encourage the children to make a

Lenten promise e.g. giving up sweets/fizzy drinks/ chocolate etc or to do something positive eg doing messages every Saturday for mum/dad/gran/neighbour; making their bed every morning etc. We would really appreciate your help and support in encouraging your child to make a Lenten promise and keep it throughout the Lenten period. We would also encourage all families to try to make a special time to pray together during Lent. These promises remind the children of Jesus' sacrifice - he died to save us from our sins so that we can enter the kingdom of Heaven. Thank you.
