At St. Peter’s we are also keen to ensure that Sports Premium Money is spent wisely with the future and continued support of pupils and staff in mind. After auditing staff and obtaining staff views regarded the provision of Physical Education within the school, it was decided that the remainder of Sports Premium Funds would be spent on utilising and bringing in quality assured external coaches. This would continue to build on the successes of the previous year. Feedback from last year showed

that the coaching was good for excelling the ability of the children, whilst promoting enjoyment of PE for pupils. Specialist coaching would continue to be used as part of staff CPD for improving the teaching and learning of PE within the school for future years. This coaching was secured for 1 academic year with coaches coming in for 3 days a week focussing on a different aspect of PE each term. This means that teacher and children could see the progression of a teaching phase more easily.
