## Key structural features

### Headline

Hook the reader in, make the reader read the article.

### Paragraphs

Paragraphs used to separate events or individuals points of view.

### Introduction

Introduce the article, answering the following questions: Who? What? Where? When

### Picture & Caption

A visual representation for the reader to understand the event.

## What should a newspaper report introduction include?

### When?

When did the event happen.

### Where?

Where has the event taking place.

### Who?

Who is involved in the event.

### What?

A brief explanation of what has happened.

## Key grammatical features

### Third person

Writing in third person removes opinion of writer.

### Usually Past tense

Usually past tense as the event has happened. Some articles are written about an upcoming event which would change the tense needed.

### Formal language

Used in news reports to maintain a neutral tone. Quotes may be informal.

### Quotes

Points of views and thoughts of people involved. Either written as direct or reported speech.

### When?

Yesterday, Late yesterday afternoon,

### Where?

Hogwarts School, In the grounds,

### Who?

A Hogwarts student, Draco Malfoy

### What?

Boy attacked by magical creature, attack on boy by hippogriff

## What does the main body of a newspaper report include?

### More information

More precise information about the event.

### Eye witness accounts

Information from those who witnessed the event.

### Quotes

Spoken words from eye witness accounts.

### Range of sentence structures

A wide range of structures such as relative clauses.

## What could the conclusion of a newspaper report include?

### A look to the future

Look forward to what could happen next.

### Appeal

An appeal to the reader for further information.

### Update

A possible update on the people involved.

## What could the headline for your newspaper be?

### Catchy

Eye-catching, stand out, grab the readers attention

### Alliteration

Words starting with the same initial sound

### Pun

Could include a pun or play on words
