

## St. Peter's Catholic Primary School COVID-19 FLOWCHART (v2)

Child / Teaching Team / Household member has symptoms or gets a positive result on the LFD test.

Book a PCR test immediately and isolate until you get the result.

ONLY the person with symptoms or the positive LFD result needs to isolate.

Everyone else in the class / household can continue as normal unless they develop symptoms or have a positive LFD result.

## PCR TEST RESULT IS POSITIVE

The person must isolate for 10 days starting the day after the onset of symptoms/positive LFD/PCR result, but he/she can take a LFD on Day 6 and a LFD on Day 7 and if both LFDs are negative, they can stop isolating at midnight of Day 7 and return to work/school on Day 8.

## **PCR IS NEGATIVE**

You do not have COVID-19.

Continue as normal.

## **CLOSE CONTACTS OF A POSITIVE PCR PERSON**

You **must** get a PCR test.

You do not need to isolate if:

- you are under 18 years 6 months
- You are 14 days clear of your second vaccination
- You are taking part or have taken part in a COVID-19 vaccine trial
  - You're not able to get vaccinated for medical reasons

You must always isolate if you do not meet this criteria.

You must always isolate if you have any of the COVID-19 symptoms and you must always get a PCR test.
