Y5 Curriculum Summary: Autumn Term 2023

ENGLISH

Children will be using 'The Journey' by Aaron Becker as their stimulus to write setting descriptions, narratives and their own action sequel.

In grammar, we will focus on word class and learning about using different types of clauses as well writing complex sentences.

SCIENCE

Properties and changes of materials:

Children will learn about different materials, their uses and their properties as well as dissolving, separating mixtures and irreversible changes. They will sort and classify objects according to their properties.

MATHEMATICS

Children will develop their skills, knowledge and understanding in the following areas: place value of whole and decimal numbers, fractions and problem-solving, Children will be applying these skills to solve real life mathematical problems.

PSHE

Health and wellbeing: Children will explore what makes a person's identity and how to recognise and respect similarities and differences between people.

HISTORY

Children will learn about the culture, lifestyle, beliefs and legacies of the Anglo Saxons and Vikings.

DT
