The Governors are aware of the non-statutory advice from the Department for Education in their document: Protection of biometric information of children in schools and colleges (March 2018).
Biometric data means personal information about an individual's physical or behavioural characteristics that can be used to identify that person; this can include their fingerprints, facial shape, retina and iris patterns, and hand measurements.
The governing board's policy is that biometric information will not be used, collected or stored by any staff member at St. Peter's Catholic Primary School.
This policy will be reviewed annually by the Local Governing Committee.
